This Synod is going to be in a hybrid format: on-site at **Huntington Methodist Church, York**, and online via Zoom.

Parking at this venue is limited. There is space for 6 cars outside of the church, and 10 assigned spaces in the car park at the Memorial Hall which will be prioritised for those who have limited mobility.
